- **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY**

The Institution observes World Environment Day every year both inside and outside the campus. On June 5, 2021, the day was celebrated by organising a plantation drive the college campus. In 2022, the N.C.C Unit of the college marked the celebration of World Environment Day with a two-day event. On June 5, 2022, in collaboration with the N.S.S Unit, the Unit organized a tree planting drive within the college premises. A total of 22 cadets participated in the drive. Additionally, on June 7, 2022, a lecture session was conducted on the topic of "Understanding Carbon Dioxide, Greenhouse Gases, and Climate Changes." The aim was to raise awareness about environmental pollution issues. The lecture saw an active attendance of 18 cadets.

A lecture programme was organised also on the occasion on the topic 'Better Environment is Better Economics' with renowned environmental activist Prof Atanu Kr. Choudhury as the resource person.
