NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME(NSS)

1. BLOOD DONATION CAMP

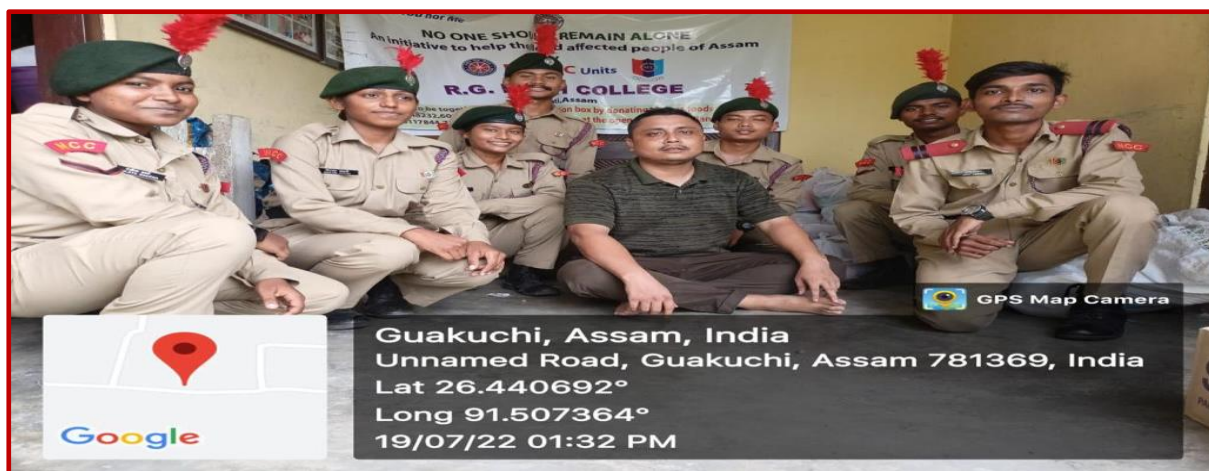
4. PLASTIC WASTE MANAGEMENT

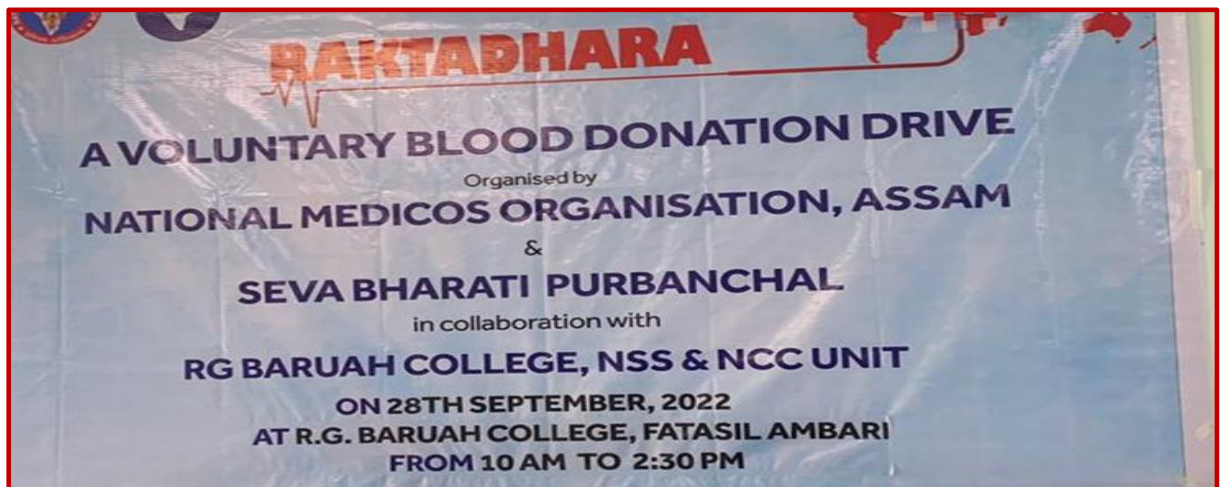
6. RAKTADHARA: A VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

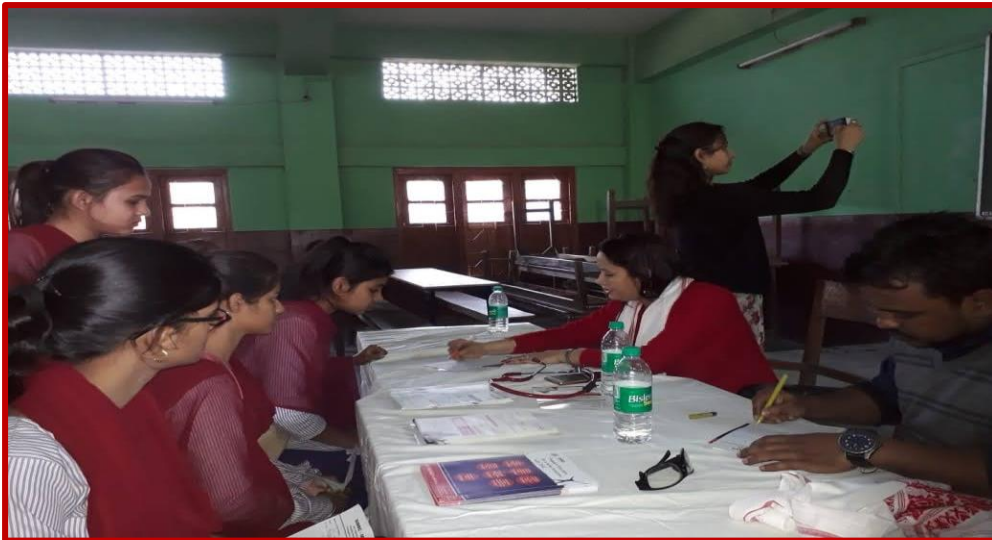

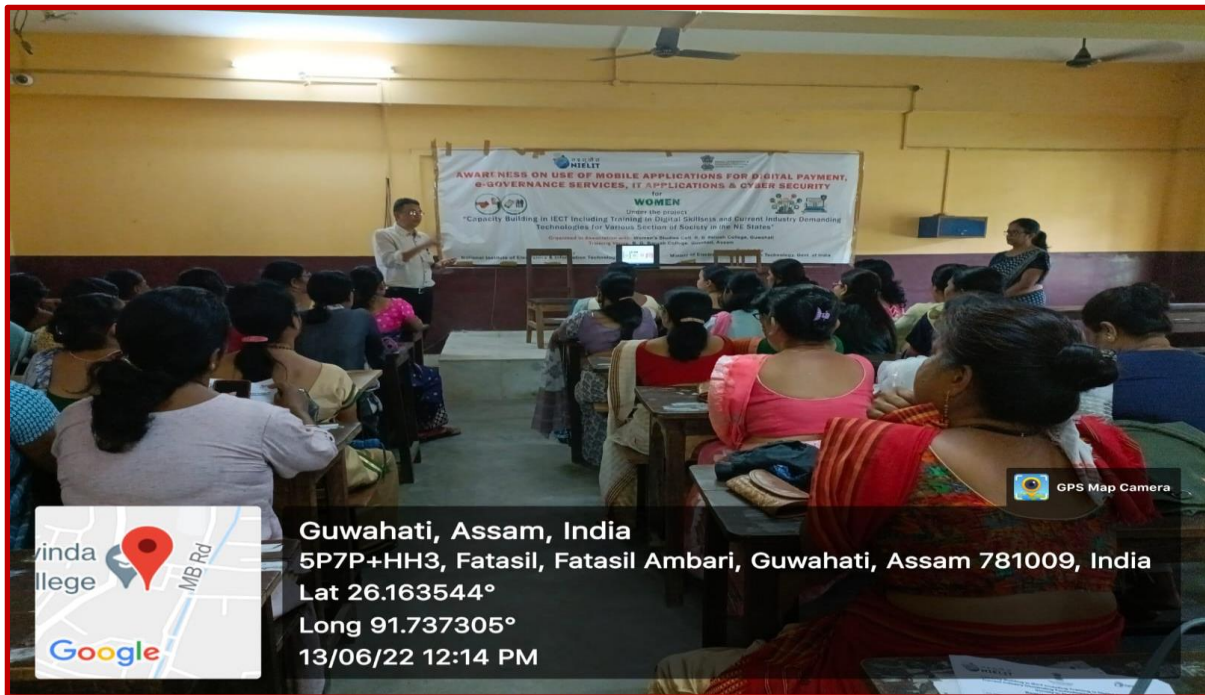
