## Feed Back report of Teachers on Course Curriculum for 2022-23

Being a part of Affiliated University, the teachers of R.G.Baruah college has to follow the course curriculum constructed by Gauhati University. To get the feedback on Curriculum, the IQAC of R.G.Baruah College has framed 8 questions on various dimensions of the Curriculum.

- Q.1 was about the usefulness of interdisciplinary approach of ongoing CBCS curriculum where 93% voted for Yes, 0% for No and 7% for not Sure.
- Q.2 was on the difficulty level of the syllabus where 93% voted for No and only 3% said Yes.
- Q.3 was on need of modification of the Course Content where 72.4% said Yes, 17% said No. and 10.6% were Not sure.
- Q.4 was about time allocation to complete the syllabus where 58% voted for Insufficient, 34% said Sufficient and remaining are Not sure.
- Q.5 was on the enquiry of helpfulness of the course for future establishment of students, 58% said yes, where 17% said No and others were Not sure.
- Q.6 was on the satisfaction of the list of tools/equipment used in the practical part of the syllabus where 37% said Yes, 37% Not sure and remaining said No.
- Q.7 was on essentiality of Project/ Field Survey/Assignment for the respective subject where 97% voted for Yes, 0% said No. 3% Not Sure.
- Q. 8 was about the Gender Sensitivity aspect of the Curriculum where 55% said Yes,38% said No. and a small portion was Not Sure.

Although most of the faculties were silent on suggestions, a suggestion for Economics (Hons) was given for redesigning the Statistics (for 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester) and Econometrics syllabus in a consistent way. Also ,in English literature syllabus, suggestion was given to incorporate Criticism part and the specialization should begin from Semester 3 onwards.
