Or

(b) Critically examine the character of Bosola in John Webster's *The Duchess of Malfi*.

Or

"I am the Duchess of Malfi still."

Assess the character of the Duchess in the light of this statement.

(c) Write a brief note on Aphra Behn's portrayal of women in *The Rover*.

Or

"Willmore is a self-conscious rake."

Do you think Aphra Behn celebrates his libertine behaviour in *The Rover*? Give reasons for your answer.

(d) What is a mock-heroic poem? Discuss Pope's The Rape of the Lock as a mock-heroic poem.

Or

"Mac Flecknoe is not only a satire, it is also a comedy." Discuss critically.

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
