National Cadet Corps (Army wing) Unit of R.G.Baruah College has kept up with its passion to take itself to a splendid platform by being active all throughout the year. From taking part in various activities of the college to organizing different social outreach programs, the Unit has done its bit to serve the society. The total strength of the Unit is 52.

This year as well the N.C.C wing has lived up to the spirit of nationalism by taking part in the celebrations of national festivals like Republic day and Independence day in the college. A total of 40 cadets performed parade drills and saluted the national flag to show their love and respect for the country. However, their performance was not confined to the college alone. A total of 18 cadets were selected to be a part of Parade Drill held at Gauhati High Court, Latashil to celebrate Independence Day on 15/08/22.

The Unit has actively participated in various activities of the college held during the year. On 2nd October, 2021 the unit organised a campus cleaning drive as a part of Swach Bharat Abhiyan. A total of 40 cadets participated in the drive and made it a success. Another, campus cleaning drive was organised on 5th June, 2022 as a part of the celebration of World Environment Day.
