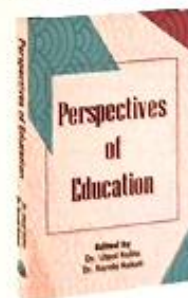
On 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, the Department published a hand written magazine 'ALOK' prepared by the departmental students.

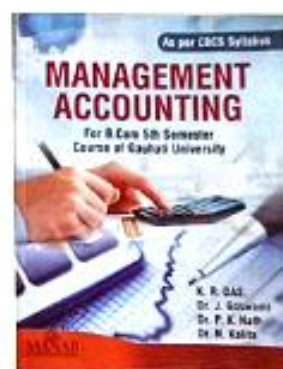


- On 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022, he was felicitated by Pratham Khabar, Guwahati.
